A Chairde,

I hope this letter finds you and your family well.

As you will be aware, Irish society has changed significantly in recent years and our community has become increasingly diverse and multi-cultural. As a reflection of the communities in which they are based, schools continually adapt to cater for all their pupils in an inclusive manner. Nationally, we have seen a growing demand from parents and guardians, from school communities and from within the Department of Education for a greater choice of school ethos to be available to pupils.
